Príncipe de Viana 1423 Reserva is made with the best grapes from selected vineyards from the estate. It is the **Jewel of the Crown**, the wine that crowns the wine line, showing the great potential of quality, expression of terroir, and complexity of Príncipe de Viana wines.

The content is the pure character of terroir, but **Príncipe de Viana 1423 Reserva** is even more. This wine symbolizes the essence of Navarra of the whole brand: 1423 was the year when Navarra's King Carlos III Noble of Navarra, created the aristocratic title of *Príncipe de Viana* for his grandson, Carlos de Trastámara and Evreux, an honour born today by Princess Leonor, heiress to Throne of Spain.

Príncipe de Viana wines are the result of a philosophy which prioritizes origin, quality, unique style, and research to offer consumers innovative solutions to their needs.

This philosophy has earned the brand the recognition of experts and the international press, and has been granted exceptional ratings from experts and specialized magazines such as International Wine Cellar, The Wine Advocate (Robert Parker), and international wine challenges like Mundus Vini or Challenge International du Vin, as well as of previous editions of Guía Peñín.
