Michael Schachner on the wine: “*aromas of cherry, plum, forest floor and tobacco feed into a clumpy palate with fresh acidity. Lightly spiced currant and red-plum flavors are limited in scope but nice, while this tastes herbal and feels tight and racy on the finish*”.

Príncipe de Viana Edición Limitada comprises the best of three different vineyards and three grape varieties, distinct terroirs with their own personalities which have been assembled to create a unique blend.

A coupage of Tempranillo, Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot from three exceptional plots, this wine is the result of a strong commitment with terroir.

This philosophy has deserved the recognition of experts like Peñín and The Wine Advocate (Robert Parker), and international competitions such as Challenge International du Vin.
