Príncipe de Viana Edición Limitada comprises the best of three different vineyards and three grape varieties, distinct terroirs with their own personalities which have been assembled to create a unique blend.

A coupage of Tempranillo, Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot from three exceptional plots, this wine is the result of a strong commitment with terroir.

This philosophy has deserved the recognition of influential magazines such as Wine Enthusiast, which has recently

granted this wine **90 points**, experts like Peñín and The Wine Advocate (Robert Parker), and international competitions such as the Challenge International du Vin.

In addition to this limited edition red wine, further references in the same range have also obtained excellent results at this edition of the Mundus Vini competition. Such is the case of the Principe de Viana Chardonnay Fermentado en Barrica 2016 which has received a GOLD MEDAL, or Principe de Viana Reserva 2012 which has been granted a Silver Medal.

Mundus Vini is an influential wine competition whose international jury is recognized by the Organisation Internationale de la Vigne et du Vin (OIV) and enjoys great prestige within the world of wine. The jury consists of winemakers, wine analysts, distributors, sommeliers, journalists and buyers and the most important international companies and enterprises.
