The round sweet tannins and a long finish with delicious notes of fruit and toast make this a warm and complex Reserva that opens gently on the palate.

Possibly one of the most renowned international competitions, Challenge International du Vin gathers thousands of wines every year and puts them to the test but only those that prove extraordinary deserve a Gold Medal.

Awards from contests alike have recognized the essence of Bodegas Príncipe de Viana: Respect for tradition and for a land that has yielded great quality wines with an incomparable personality for centuries.
